- (i) The results may be moderated on need based basis.
- (ii) The scholars may be considered to have passed the course work on the basis of cumulative score of 55% but they must also secure minimum 40% of marks in the Oral as well as written components of the exam.
- (iii) It is compulsory for all the scholars to make submission in each component of the exam.
- (iv) In case of reappearance in either (written or oral) exam; all submission are to be resubmitted.


