

NOTICE FOR LL. B / LL.M ADMISSION 2018-2019

Applicant has to report personally on the date of Counselling before the Admission Committee in the New Building of Faculty of Law, Umang Bhawan, Chatra Marg along with the following documents: -

1. Admission Ticket of Entrance Test 2018
2. Downloaded Original Form filled for Entrance Test from DU Website (du.ac.in) in PG Portal
3. Downloaded Admission Form of Faculty of Law Uploaded on D.U. Website
4. Downloaded undertaking form of Anti Ragging from below mentioned link:

5. Age Certificate (High School / Matriculation)
6. Character certificate not older than six Months
7. Degree of qualifying exam (Graduation/Post graduation) or Provisional Certificate in case Degree is not issued by the University with a proof for the same
8. Mark sheet of the Qualifying Degree Examination
9. SC/ST/OBC/CW/PwD certificate should be in the candidate's name only. The non-creamy layer certificate of OBC candidate should be of 2017-2018
10. Five Passport Size Photograph.
11. Migration Certificate
12. For claiming fee reduction in case of SC/ST applicants, a self-attested declaration that their Parent's income is not taxable.
13. Photocopy of all above listed Documents (Self Attested)

Note: -

1. Those applicants who have appeared in qualifying degree examination and whose result of qualifying exam has not been declared are also required to attend the counselling personally if their name appeared in the admission List. A candidate whose name appears in the admission list but she/he does not report in person on the designated days will not be entitled to admission at any subsequent date.

2. Applicants seeking admission to two year LL.M. course are required to give an affidavit at the time of admission that she/he is not in employment or engaged in any trade, profession and business or occupation and will not take up any of them during the LL.M. course. The Performa for Affidavit is on the Delhi University website. The Affidavit has to be on stamp paper duly executed by the notary/ magistrate.
