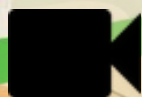

3. The abstract should provide a comprehensive paper overview, clearly stating the theme, specific topic, methodology, aims, and scope.
4. Double-blind peer review system
5. All participants will be provided with - a certificate of participation. Best 50 papers will be published in Book Published by The Project Saksham the first edition.

The title should be concise and descriptive, not exceeding 15 words. It should be in bold font and center alignment.

## Author Details:

- Provide the full name, designation, institution, College Ids, and contact details (email and phone number) of all authors.
- Co-authorship is permitted with a maximum of two authors per submission.
- Submissions must be original, unpublished work and should not have been submitted, published, or presented elsewhere.
- Upon acceptance, detailed paper submission guidelines, and a link will be provided to make the payment.

## Submission Process:

- The deadline for submission is 18th April, 2025.
- Late submissions will not be entertained.

## Review Process:

- A panel of the editorial board will conduct a review for each submission.

- Accepted papers/abstracts will be presented at the conference as oral presentations.

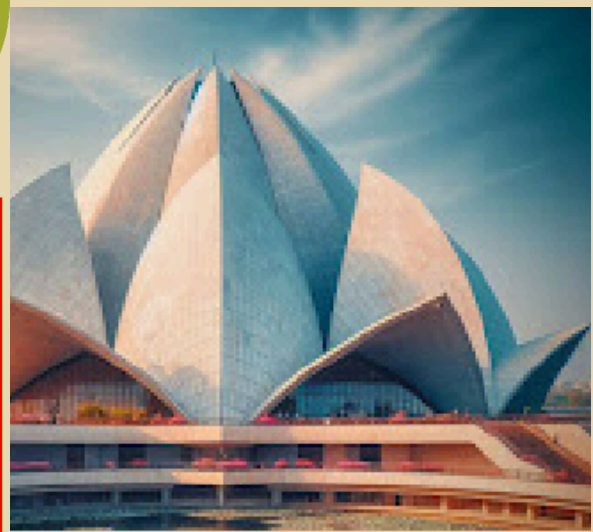

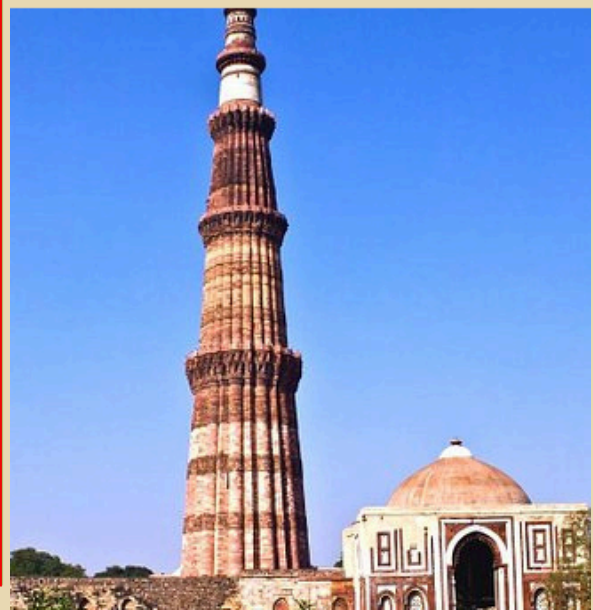
