**WORKING IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENTAL LAW**



As a part of the **Centenary Celebrations of the Faculty of Law, University of Delhi** and **75 Years of Working of the Constitution of India**, the Faculty of Law, University of Delhi is proudly organising a 'National Research Colloquium for Early Career Scholars Working in the Field of Environmental Law' on the International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer i.e., September 16, 2024.

**Purpose:** To provide a platform to early career scholars of the nation to discuss global environmental concerns, role of the Constitution of India in protect environment and to create opportunities for the early career scholars to present their on-going research work before experts as well as other scholars, receive feedback on their draft papers, learn about several aspects of publishing environmentally and socially relevant academic papers and promote exchange of knowledge, thoughts and ideas amongst emerging scholars working on environmental law.

**Selection:** The paper presenters shall be selected based on a draft working paper on environmental law and a statement of purpose. We look forward to receiving research papers on the triple planetary crisis, the role of Constitution to combat Climate Change, national environmental laws and policies of India, challenges in implementation, workable solutions, and India's role in combating global environmental crisis. These topics are only indicative.

<b><i>Who are eligible?</i></b>	<p><b>As Paper Presenters:</b></p> <p>Assistant professors including those working as guest faculty members, legal professionals, Ph.D. scholars who have either completed their Ph.D. degree or who are currently pursuing their Ph.D. research on topics relating to environmental challenges/ sociological perspectives to environment, environmental laws and policies. The age limit for such applicants who wish to apply as paper presenters is 35 years.</p> <p><b>As Other Participants</b></p> <p>Faculty members having keen interest in the field of environmental law and Students pursuing LL.M. are encouraged to apply and attend the programme as other participants.</p>
<b><i>Application Process</i></b>	<p>Applicants may apply either as paper presenters or as other participants by filling up the google form via <a href="https://forms.gle/716KCUa42zES2rqg7">https://forms.gle/716KCUa42zES2rqg7</a> by <b>August 31, 2024</b>.</p> <p>Applicants applying as paper presenters have to send their draft paper (5000-6000 words including footnotes) and a brief statement of purpose (not more than 500 words) along with their CV. The selected paper presenters will be informed about the outcome of their paper by <b>September 09, 2024</b>.
